Resolution is required by August 6, 2016.

Ivy Tech Community College - Northwest, East Chicago, IN

Accreditation Decision Deferred

The decision regarding the accreditation status of the following program is deferred until the October 23, 2016 meeting pending receipt of additional documentation.

Kansas City Kansas Community College, Kansas City, KS

Other actions taken by the Committee on Accreditation did not affect the accredited status of the programs involved.
